
HospiceCare's Virtual Open Gardens 2020



As a Deacon I am committed to saying the Morning and Evening Prayer of the Church, when lockdown started, I was very grateful that the Catholic church on King Street in Seahouses is connected to our house. That meant that, even though the church had to be closed. I could be in there and keep the prayers going in that place of prayer. Lots of people have asked me to pray during lockdown particularly. I've prayed for children, I've prayed for sister's and brother's, I've prayed for father's and mother's, for good friends, for prisoners, for victims of crime, for prison officers and I've prayed for our community here in this area. Some of the people I've prayed for have had the Coronavirus and have got better, some have died, including my own brother. I have hoped that people would be healed and some have been but for some the healing was arriving in heaven and being actually in the presence of God and the angels and of course the people that they have loved, who lived before them. My wife and I and family got together in Northampton for a 40th birthday party just before lockdown and a few of us believe that is where we caught the virus. I was so very grateful that after three weeks of it I was back at work. I know some who have taken up to twelve weeks to only just start feeling anything like normal again.

I never thought that I would ever be grateful for WhatsApp but staying connected to my family through the different groups that we have has been very important. I have been grateful for the internet and ZOOM calls with family, even the quizzes!! I've been ringing around our parishioners most weeks and I've had some very interesting conversations — I'm grateful for them and their company, our connections and the things that we have in common.



They closed the golf course for weeks on end and that made me get my bike out of the garage and get my exercise in a different way – that made me appreciate the beautiful countryside we have around here and I was grateful for quiet country lanes with no traffic. When the tide was out, I rode along to Beadnell and along the beach, through the estuary and back and I'm sure that you noticed the amazing weather that we had – the morning sunrises were simply stunning.

I think working as the Catholic Chaplain at HMP Northumberland helped me to appreciate the outdoors, my own freedom and having my family connections, even though they were limited. The lads in our prison, 1340 of them, have been and still are locked up for around 23 hours a day – only out to collect their meals, 5 at a time and then half an hour a day and in that time they have to order what they need, shower and exercise. Working there the last 11 weeks, particularly, has made me realise just how fortunate I have been, even in the restrictions.

Just before I typed this Anna, my wife, and I have deep cleaned the church ready for the Diocesan Health and Safety Manager to come and conduct a risk assessment with a view to opening up our church. The village is buzzing with visitors enjoying what we have been able to enjoy during lockdown, the beaches, the fresh air and the wonderful scenery and the local economy is starting to get back onto its feet again – so important for so many!!

I hope that I have been able to convey to you my attitude of gratitude and I hope that whoever reads this is able to reflect on what they have been grateful for even in this most difficult of times.
