
## Community Library at The Hub

## Timely Garden Tips. April and May 2022

You may have forgotten to sow tomato seeds but there is still time to get free plants which will fruit this summer. Many growers will be currently removing side shoots from their cordon tomato plants. Ask a friend to leave one side shoot to grow to about 6 inches, 15 cm, then snap it out and place in a glass of water for you.

The side shoot can then be planted up in a small pot, watered and covered in a plastic milk bottle, with the bottom cut off and the lid removed. Place in a light place and roots will soon grow. Carefully remove the plastic bottle and acclimatize the plant to a sunny windowsill or greenhouse. Pot on to bigger plant pots as required. Plants can also be planted out in the garden in a warm, sunny sheltered spot. Don't forget to nip out any later side shoots!

Hopefully the frosts are over and nights are warming up.

Cymbidium orchids, the kind with sprays of flowers and many strappy leaves growing from what appears to be bulbs, frequently grown as houseplants, flower better if placed outside for the summer in a sheltered spot. Remember to water them occasionally and to bring them back inside before the cold nights return. This doesn't work for Moth Orchids (*Phalaenopsis*) often sold in supermarkets, which require a much warmer spot.

The warm weather encourages algae to develop in ponds. If the water in yours turns green try adding watercress. A bag of watercress leaves from the greengrocers or supermarket, roots in a week if emptied into a large bowl of water, glass works best, and left on a windowsill. Once the young plants are well rooted, rinse them in clean water and throw them into the pond. You should see the green water disappear in a couple of weeks. Unfortunately, this tip doesn't work on Blanket Weed which still needs to be removed manually.



## Free Plant Pots!

Beadnell Plant Pot Store was set up 6 years ago to keep unwanted plant pots out of landfill or from being incinerated. Anyone is welcome to leave their unwanted pots at the table in the entrance to Peal

House, The Wynding, Beadnell, NE67 5BU at any time. The driveway is opposite the entrance to Beadnell Towers Hotels' car park. The Pot Stores owner Jen Hall sorts the pots into size and shape and stores them in a shed in her garden.

Anyone is then welcomed to help themselves to as many pots as they like, free of charge. Depending on demand, Jen usually has a stock of special clear orchid pots, pond plant pots, modules for seedlings, tall pots for roses or climbers and a limited number of large pots for veg growing, tomatoes or displays. Jen also finds good homes with new gardeners for unwanted garden tools or sundries.

## Letter from the Vicar March / April 2022

I seem to always be writing these letter to you in some time of crisis. Lent in 2020 and 2021 was marked but the way in which Covid 19 made such an effect on our lives and our families.

Now as Covid begins to fade but is far from gone we are faced by the the first time since WW2 that a sovereign nation has invaded a neighbour as Russia has invaded Ukraine. As I write this on 15 March we see Russian forces renewing attacks and Kyey and I have no idea what the situation will be when you read this.

Alongside this barbaric attack we have seen amazing acts of generosity in Europe and in the UK. Anyone who saw the mountains of Aid at the Hub in Seahouses and Bell View in Belford could not doubt the generosity of our neighbours. However we will also have the opportunity to welcome and support refugees over the coming months and Im sure we can step up to this.

Lent is a time when we look at the frailty and brokenness of human nature not only in president Putin but also in ourselves and we ask god to forgive our faults and help us to live generous lives. The prophet Micah says

“what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness and to walk humbly with your God?”

These are words to take to heart.

The chief Rabbi of Ukraine has asked people to pray Psalm 31 as a way of supporting the people of Ukraine and I commend this to you.

At the end of Lent we celebrate Holy Week and Easter with the promise that good overcomes evil, life overcomes death and light overcomes darkness. I pray this is an experience for all of us in Ukraine and the UK this year

All over the world, birds are preparing for spring migration, with some literally travelling to the other side of the globe to reach their summer breeding grounds!



At Space for Shorebirds, spring can only mean one thing – shorebird nesting season is upon us! Last year was our first nesting season since the service was set up, and we learned a lot of valuable lessons about the challenges our nesting shorebirds face, especially ringed plovers. We were thankful to receive lots of kind support from residents and visitors alike and we are looking forward to returning this year to help the birds once again.

The beach-nesting season occurs at the same time that the beaches become busier for people and dogs, meaning they are very vulnerable to disturbance. We help give the birds a helping hand towards having a successful season by protecting their nests using fencing and signage. Please keep an eye out for these nest protection areas when you are on the coast during the spring and summer and give them lots of space to keep the nesting birds free from disturbance.

Let us know of children that would like to grow flowers and/ or vegetables for the show so we can make sure we are able to make provision for them.



